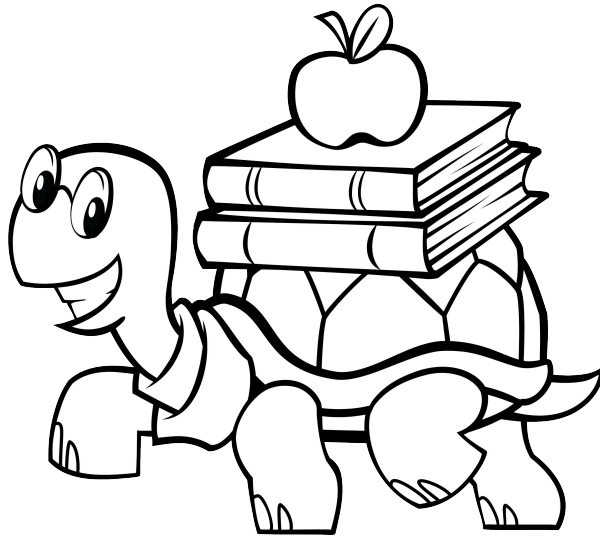

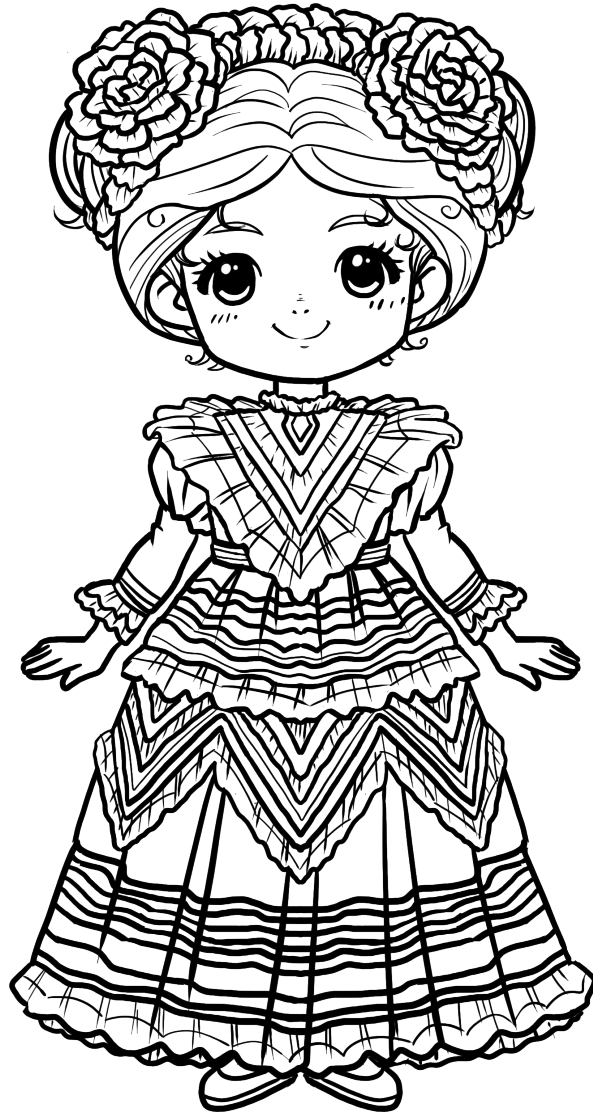

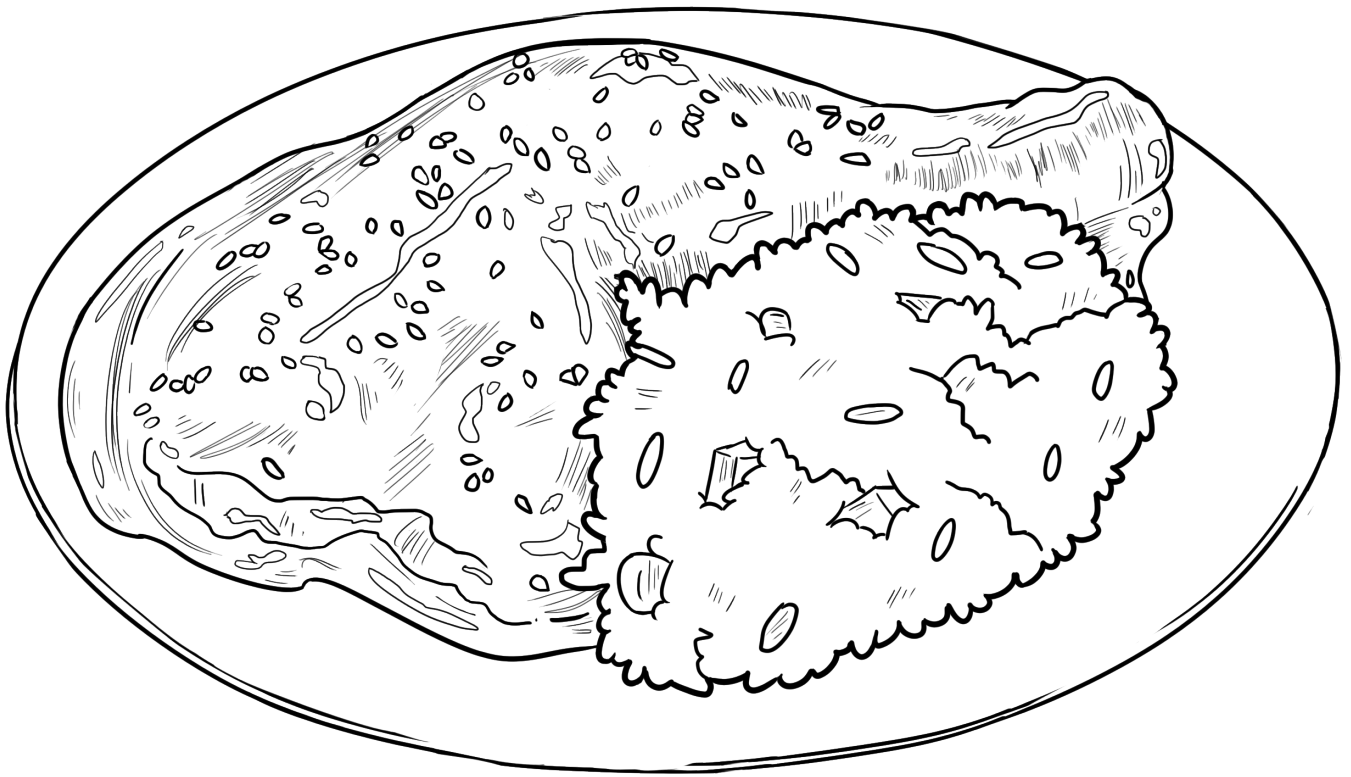
This Month



This boy wears the outfit of a traditional mariachi band, typically featuring stringed instruments like violins, guitarróns, and vihuelas, along with trumpets. The bands perform traditional Mexican songs and ranchera music, known for their lively rhythms and emotional lyrics.



This girl wears a traditional Mexican dress, often of bright colors and worn during dance performances and other cultural expressions. Some indigenous communities in Mexico wear traditional clothing like this in daily life with styles varying depending upon the region.



This traditional dish, Molé Poblano, is the official dish of Cinco de Mayo because the day commemorates Mexico's victory over the French at the Battle of Puebla. Its delicious ingredients include dried chiles, chocolates and vegetables.
