

WindSock Craft

Create your own colorful windsock to capture the last breezes of summer using simple materials and a splash of creativity!

Materials:

- Empty toilet paper roll
- Glue stick
- White paper/Colored paper
- Tissue paper/ribbons/streamers (any colors)
- String
- Tape
- Scissors
- Compass/divider or sharp pencil
- Colored pencils or markers
- Tooth pick

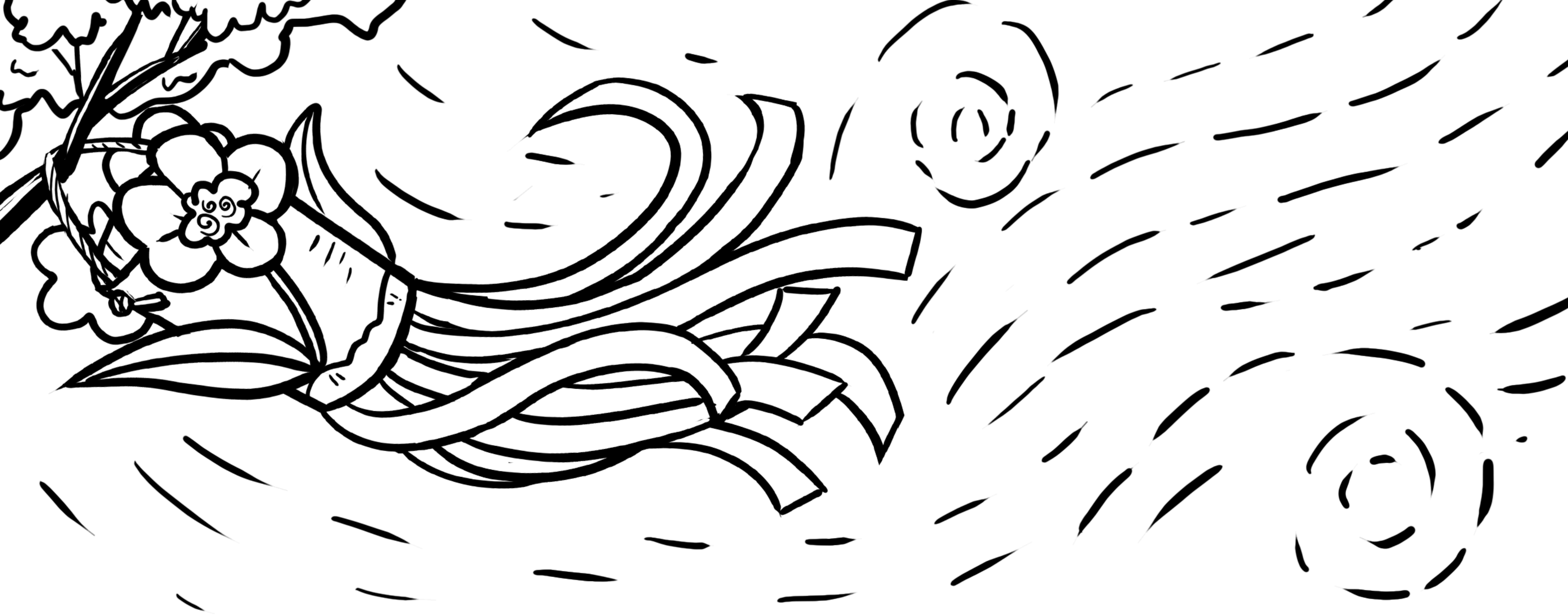
Instructions:

Prepare Your Workspace

- Gather all the materials and tools you need.

Prepare the toilet paper roll:

- Using the glue stick, cover the toilet paper roll with paper.
- Cut off any excess paper.
- Cut or draw shapes found in nature like grass, bugs, leaves and flowers.
- Place any extra elements on your toilet paper roll using a glue stick.



Prepare the string for hanging:

- Cut out 8-10" of string.
- Use a compass and pierce 2 holes into the toilet paper roll.
- Use a toothpick to help push the strings edge through the holes.
- Tie two knots on either end of the string.
- Adjust the strings to an appropriate length.
- Cut off any excess string.

Finish our windsock:

- Cut the tissue paper into long vertical skinny strips.
- Tape each strip to the inside of the toilet paper roll from the bottom.
- Decorate with as many strips, ribbons or streamers as you'd like.
- Hang somewhere nice so it can blow in the wind.
