
Coloring Activity Día de los Muertos

La Catrina is a famous elegant skeleton lady wearing a fancy hat. An artist created her to teach a lesson: death comes to everyone, rich or poor. During Día de los Muertos, some people paint their faces to look like La Catrina with beautiful decorations.



What is a calavera and how does it look?:

- White or pale base covering the entire face (representing a skull)
- Black circles around the eyes (eye sockets)
- Black triangular nose (skull nasal cavity)
- Vertical lines on the lips/mouth area (showing teeth)



"Calavera Makeup"

Face painting that transforms a living person's face to look like a decorative skull, specifically inspired by La Calavera Catrina.



Face painting became popular in the late 20th century, especially in urban Día de los Muertos celebrations and parades.
