





A menorah is a nine-branched candelabrum lit during Hanukkah's eight nights.




The Star of David is a symbol of Jewish identity and heritage.




Olives were used to make the oil that miraculously lasted eight days in the Temple.




Potatoes are used to make fried latkes that are traditionally eaten during Hanukkah to commemorate the miracle of the oil.



A single candle stayed lit for eight days, sustained by the miracle of the oil.



A Sufganiyot is a jelly-filled doughnut fried in oil, a traditional Hanukkah treat.



A dreidel is a small spinning top with four sides, used in a traditional game during Hanukkah.
